4C For Children was founded on April 1, 1970 and we are the Child Care Resource & Referral Agency (CCR&R) serving the Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Washington, and Waukesha Counties in southeastern Wisconsin. 4C offers a variety of services that support quality Early Care and Education. We provide training for existing and new child care providers, help parents navigate the process of child care options available, work closely with the State of Wisconsin regarding the delivery of YoungStar services, and provides a USDA Food Service program for Family Child Care Providers. 4C is recognized as a thought leader in the field of early education. The Main office is located in Milwaukee, with satellite offices in Racine and Washington counties.

4C For Children was privileged to continue work towards our two main objectives in 2019 of supporting Early Care and Education **Programs and connecting families** to these programs.

In 2019, 4C interacted directly with child care providers through technical assistance and training allowing the opportunity to work with providers to support them in providing safe, healthy, and educational environments for children ages birth to school-age. We also worked with parents to help them find quality child care that meets the needs of each family and increased our reach by attending numerous community events. We continued to partner with ResCare and MAXIMUS to provide families and providers with financial support for the cost of child care, making quality care accessible and affordable for families.
