This course provides an introduction to the six vital components of early literacy, based on early learning standards and current research. Strategies are included to address Dual Language Learner needs. The target audience for training includes all teachers and providers serving children in the birth through 5 years range. While adaptations and modifications to meet the needs of individual children are strongly encouraged, universal practices are the primary focus of this training.
