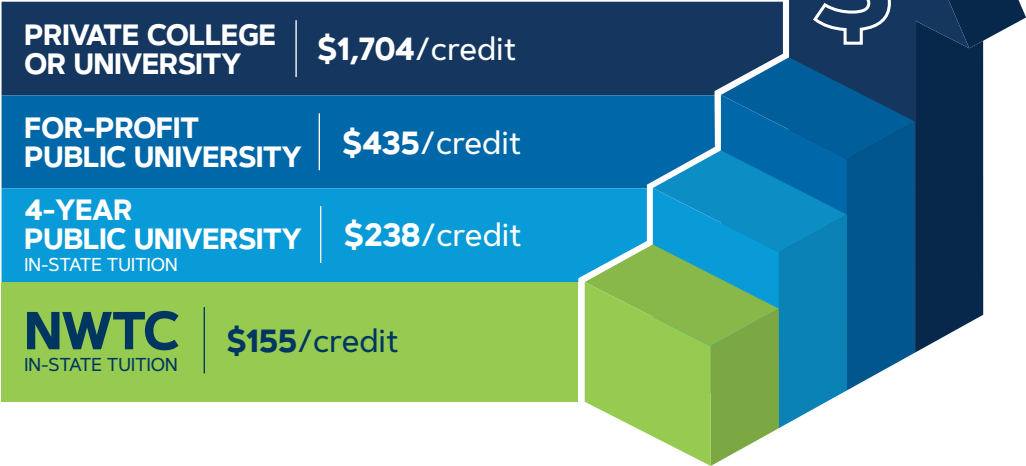

YOUR COLLEGE EDUCATION

through dual credit opportunities like Start College Now, Youth Apprenticeship, Transcribed Credit, and more — at no cost to you! You'll earn college credit while earning credit toward high school completion at the same time.

START COLLEGE NOW *(Formerly Youth Options)*

Take college-level classes at NWTC for both college and high school credit. You do not pay for the college course if your high school board authorizes your participation. Contact your high school counselor and submit your class choices to your school board by March 1 for the fall semester and October 1 for the spring semester.

YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP

Take occupational classes at the same time you practice skills learned on the job, with a mentor as your on-site teacher.

ADVANCED STANDING

Take a high school course that is determined to be a close match to an NWTC course. If you earn a "B" or better, you may earn the opportunity to skip an introductory level course in a college program and advance to the next level.

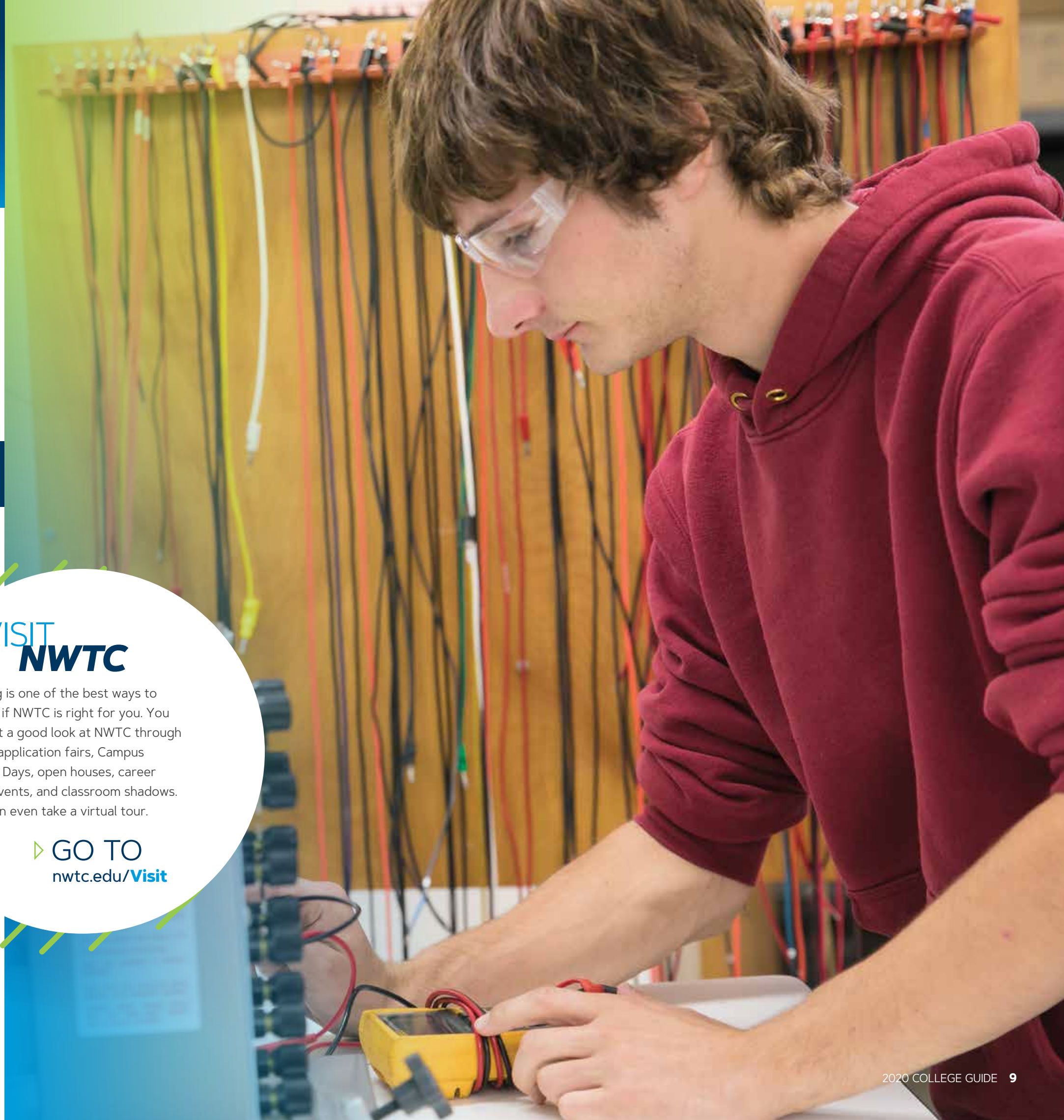
TRANSCRIBED CREDIT

Take college courses at your high school. With Transcribed Credit courses, you can earn credit at the high school and college levels, but you must earn a "C" or better for the transcribed course to become part of your official college record. High school instructors, who are trained and mentored by NWTC faculty, teach the courses. Transcribed credit courses are transferable to other Wisconsin technical colleges and may transfer to four-year universities.

3 FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

- Create an FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov.**
If you are a dependent student, one of your parents will also need an FSA ID to electronically sign your FAFSA.
- Apply for financial aid at fafsa.gov.**
 - Application is available after October 1 for the next fall enrollment.
 - Complete the FAFSA after tax return for the previous year has been filed (NWTC Federal **School Code-005301**).
- Watch mail or NWTC email** for letter from the financial aid office indicating NWTC has received your FAFSA. All financial aid communication will be conducted through your NWTC email.
- If required, submit required documents** or take required actions to complete your financial aid application as soon as possible.
